It seems that fall has finally decided to come out of hiding! The temperatures are getting cooler and we're pulling out the warm-weather gear. We hope you are all doing well.

Thank you for praying for our last two speaking engagements. We were grateful for the chance to share at our home church and then at the Church of the Great Commission, in Orlando, Florida. On the way to Orlando, we visited two of Katherine's friends from university days, one family from former church days, and a family she'd known in Haiti. What a blessing all the visits were. And this past Saturday, I (KC) enjoyed sharing at Calvary Baptist Church, in Upper Marlboro, MD. I was welcomed with open arms and enjoyed getting to know these precious saints.

Rolf's mother and brother were intended to visit us from 15-26 October, but due to mechanical problems on their plane, they ended up returning to Switzerland. Soon thereafter, Rolf's mom offered him funds to come to Switzerland. Rolf will be in Switzerland from 6-13 November. **Pray for safety in travel and that he has a good time with his family.**

Since our arrival in the States, we've been living at about 70% of our budget. For the past several months, we've asked you to pray that Rolf would find a job. We are grateful that the Lord has provided Rolf with a part-time job with FedEx Home Delivery. Rolf is still working remotely as director of our work in the Central African Republic. **Pray for Rolf's transition into working in the US and the Lord's wisdom for him to prioritize well his time.**

Katherine is enjoying her internship at the International Relations Office of Wycliffe's sister organization, SIL. The first couple weeks of work were hard. Adjusting to her 1.5 hour commute (one way) and getting back into the swing of regular work hours was a challenge. But the work itself...AHH! It's really great to be learning more about our holistic approach to meeting needs of the people in less-advantaged areas of the world. **Pray the Lord will put Katherine in the path of those she needs to meet, in order to fulfill her purpose in this position.**

We are sending out our new color brochure, with basic information about the need for Bible translation and our specific roles in advancing the Kingdom of God. What a blessing it is to the Body of Christ to participate in what the Lord is doing in the uttermost parts of the earth. **Help connect us with other like-minded people**, who want to help the disenfranchised in the world.

Before closing, we'd ask you to **pray for our colleague, Ade Mokoko**. Ade has had sciatic nerve problems since mid July and is in Yaoundé, Cameroon seeking medical care. Let us pray that she will find the help she needs and be healed from this excruciating pain.
